

SIKA / MBCC DIESEL MODEL VERSION 2.1 (12/2021)

1. GUIDING PRINCIPLES

Changes of the Diesel surcharge are calculated based on the following principles:

- 1. Official sources determine the base for adjustments.
- 2. An adjustment of the freight agreements will be performed on a monthly basis applying a defined threshold.
- 3. Equal treatment the same adjustment factors are used for increases as well as decreases of the Diesel surcharge.
- 4. **Traceability**: Applicable values shall be documented in the respective freight agreement.

The SIKA / MBCC Diesel model, latest version, is an integral part of the SIKA / MBCC "General Terms and Conditions" for road and intermodal transportation in Europe. Any other Diesel price model will not be accepted by SIKA / MBCC.



1. GUIDING PRINCIPLES

Calculation principles



Monthly Average

- Calculation as an average per month and country
- The Diesel price value of the country of the transport source / loading point is applicable

Threshold

 Any deviations of the monthly average Diesel price value of at least +/- 10% lead to an adjustment of the Diesel surcharge

Applicable surcharges



- The same adjustment factors are used for increases and decreases
- The adjustment factors always refers to the <u>base freight</u> and NOT to an already diesel-adjusted rate
- Adjustment factors will increase/decrease by steps of 2,75



 The Diesel price reference value and the applicable adjustment factor shall be documented in the respective freight agreement


1. GUIDING PRINCIPLES

Reference value

- If not specified by SIKA / MBCC, the reference value is the average
 Diesel price value of the month previous to the final price setting
- Any Diesel adjustment leads to a new reference value
- The new reference value is >/= 10% above or below the previous baseline



2. PROCESS OF DIESEL PRICE ADJUSTMENTS





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The average Diesel price value of the previous month is available usually between on the 10th and the 15th calendar day of the following month

SIKA / MBCC Logistics Procurement will check and identify which freight rate agreements are subject to surcharge / deduction SIKA / MBCC Logistics Procurement will version / maintain the freight rate agreements concerned and inform the service provider accordingly The new Diesel price surcharge/deduction is implemented starting the 1st calendar day of the following month at the latest







- Surcharges / deductions strictly refer to the average value of the previous month
